

VCS ON THE FORBES MIDAS LIST 2017

China broke through on the Forbes Midas List 2017 with 16 China venture capitalists and 7 Chinese startup unicorns factoring in the rankings.


This year's Midas list well represents long-time China venture investment firms, most of them with close links to Silicon Valley. Sequoia Capital China has 3 partners on the list while GGV Capital has 2. Other firms that made the mark are Qiming Venture Partners, IDG Capital, DCM Ventures, Lightspeed China and GSR Ventures.




