









'Koramangala's Biz is in Dabba Service'

K'mangala Hackathon for Mobile Innovation

Start-up organises event to develop applications for handset without Internet or 3G connections

HEN we say 'mobile app' the first thing comes in our mind is a smartphone and 8C connection. But Deepak Ravindran, cofounder and CEO of innoz technology, a mobile innovation venture head-quartered in Koramangala begs to differ. "You don't need a smartphone to become smart," he said.

All mobile apps do not need an Internet connection. They can be used through SMSs as well. Emphasising on the same, Innoz technology expands their market visibility by opening a new platform, 55444. in aimed at app developers where SMS-based applications can be developed for the masses. The platform uncovers new avenues for technologists in the mobile space and is expected to help Innoz to reap higher revenues.

The purpose of this platform is to develop an innovative SMS-based application that will give access to internet through SMS. Innoz technology is known for their flagship product called, 55444, which is an offline search engine, one can send a query via SMS and get the answers on SMS.

The platform, 55444, in is a business development tool for the company, as Ravindran snaps, "The product will

get better and richer, we will make profits and this will expand the visibility of Innoz."

It seems that the company is strengthening its business by involving people from outside. "There is a limit to what we can think, so there these technologists can come and add more to SMS world," elaborated Rakesh Haridas, chief marketing officer of Inno.

Since, SMS-based applications needs more popularity, the company organised a 36-hour hackathon, where about 150 technologists wrote codes for various anns

for various apps.

A Hackathon is "an intensive marathon of brainstorming and programming, where software developers and decignors collaborate to greate a new

tools for solving a set of problems."

HACKATHON & EXPANSION

Talking about the market for SMS apps and app developers in India Ravindran sounded optimistic. Out of the 1.2 billion people living India, 950 million people are mobile phone users, ensuring that the potential market for SMS-based apps is much higher than the Internet, which is used by

only 10 percent of the population.

The platform will not only give revenues and recognition to Innoz but also to the developers as they will get a revenue share up to 50 percent per hit.

"Activities like dance, music and so

"Activities like dance, music and so on are being featured so much but no body is thinking about tech talent, India is no less than Silicon Valley in this sense, so I would like to showcase these developers through hacka-

thons," spoke Deepak.
He also added that SMS market out here is huge, even if we see the telecom regulations like 200 SMS cap and all, the pull market (where people will get the message only when they ask for it) has no harm, and this market opportunity gives different and new career opportunities to people passionate about this field.

"Once awareness is made about these opportunities, more entrepreneurs will come up to drive Indian Economy farther," opined Ravindran

Li2 programmed a device to monitor the patient's heartbeat and sends smalerts using the 55444 platform to the nearest hospital or doctor in case of any irregularities in the patient's heart beats.
